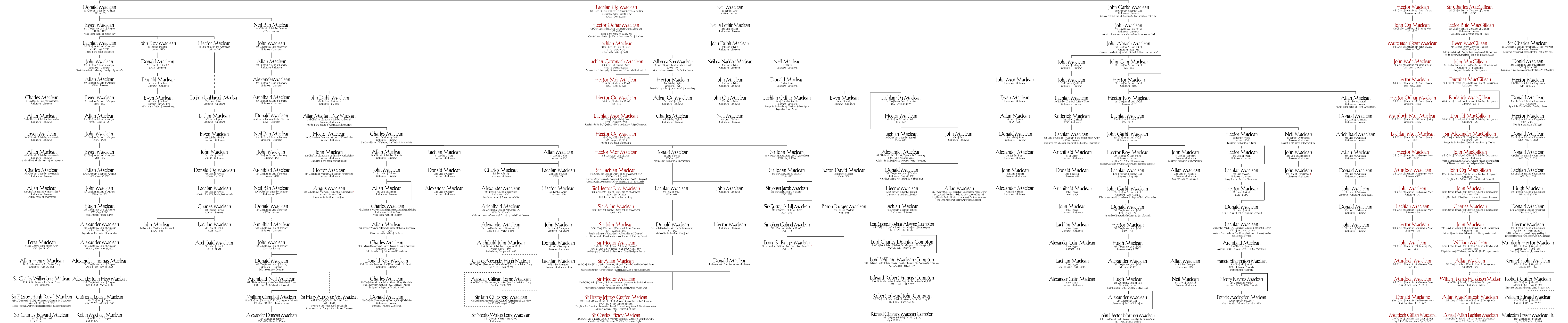




# The Clan Maclean

The Branches, Chiefs, and Chieftains of the Children of Gilleain



An ancient Gaelic Scottish Highland family with history extending from time immemorial, the Macleans (all descendants of Gilleain na Tuaisge) developed into three unique clans with more than forty notable branches.

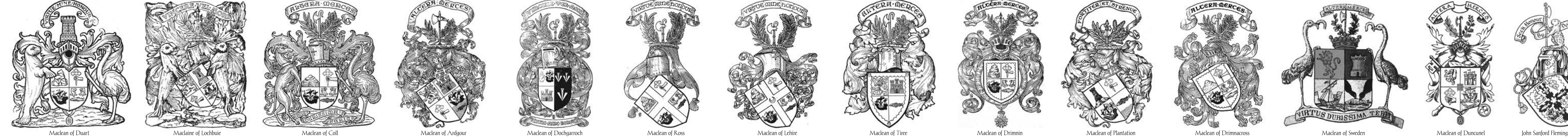
Gilleain na Tuaisge's great-grandfather is certain to have been Aul'd Douglas of Scone, born c1030 and served as a Judge and Counsellor to David I King of Scots. The Books of Ballymore, Lecan, the Skene Manuscript, and Macfarlane Genealogies concur that Ferguist Abhtarrauidh (Fergus Mac) King of Dalriada, was Gilleain na Tuaisge's great-grandfather. Dr. Beaton, Dr. Kennedy and the O'Clery Genealogies include Eic, a sixth-century King of Dalriada, as Gilleain's great-grandfather. Dr. Beaton alone asserts that Gilleain's great-grandfather is Turmhich teannach righ Eran, a King of Dal Caim in ancient Ireland, who presumably lived 320 years before the common era.
