An ancient Gaelic Scottish Highland family with history extending from time immemorial, the Macleans (all descendents of Gilleain na Tuaighe) developed into three unique clans with more than forty notable branches. Gilleain na Tuaigh's great's grandfather is certain to have been Auld Douglad of Scone, born c1030 and served as a Judex and Councillor to David I King of Scots. The Books of Ballymote, Leccan, the Skene Manuscript, and MacFirbis' Genealogies concur that Ferghuis Abhraruoidh (Fergus Mór), King of Dálriada, was Gilleain na Tuaigh's great¹⁶ grandfather. Dr. Beaton, Dr. Kennedy and the O'Clery Genealogies include Erc, a sixth-century King of Dálriada, as Çilleain's great¹⁹ grandfather. Dr. Beaton alone asserts that Çilleain's great³⁴ grandfather is Tuirmhich teainrich righ Eran, a King of Dál Cuinn in ancient Ireland, who presumably lived 32O years before the common era.


