

An ancient Gaelic Scottish Highland family with history extending from time immemorial, the Clan Maclean-all descendants of Gilleain na Tuaighe-developed into five unique clans with more than forty notable branches. Gilleain na Tuaigh's great⁵ grandfather is certain to have been Auld Douglad of Scone, born c1030 and served as a Judex and Councillor to David I King of Scots. The Books of Ballymote, Leccan, the Skene Manuscript, and MacFirbis' Genealogies concur that Ferghuis Abhraruoidh (Fergus Mór), King of Dálriada, was Gilleain na Tuaigh's great¹⁶ grandfather. Dr. Beaton, Dr. Kennedy and the O'Clery Genealogies include Erc, a sixth-century King of Dálriada, as Gilleain's great⁹⁹ grandfather. Dr. Beaton alone asserts Gilleain's great³⁴ grandfather to be Tuirmhich teainrich righ Eran (Àengus Turmhi-Temhrach), an ancient Irish King of Dál Cuinn, who presumably ruled 380 BCE.


